This information is brought to you by the National Peer Review Programme, hosted by NHS England.

My Cancer Treatment provides up to date and accessible information about NHS cancer services in England, for most of the common cancers and some of the rarer cancers.

The reports available provide information to help you decide where to go for your cancer treatment. This includes:

- How well the team compares to all the other teams in the country providing similar services
- Identification of any serious concerns or immediate risks, highlighting where they have been any compromise to quality of patient care, or risk to patient or staff safety
- If the cancer service has all relevant members of the team, including a clinical nurse specialist
- Percentage of patients seen by the hospital, within the cancer waiting times standards, set by the Department of Health
- Survey results about how other cancer patients rate their experiences of care in that hospital

## 1. Search by location

Search for NHS cancer services anywhere in England by inserting the city or postcode.

Follow these three easy steps to find your cancer treatment and compare NHS cancer services across England.

- 1. Enter your Location**  
Enter City or Postcode and press return
- 2. Select your Cancer Service by either:**  
Part of Body | Treatment | Clinical Team
- 3. Choose the Hospital**  
Type or select the Trust or Hospital name from the list



## 2. Identify your Cancer Service by either:

Choose from drop down list of body areas

### Treatment

Choose either chemotherapy or radiotherapy services

### Clinical Team

Select the clinical team of doctors and other healthcare professionals who treat the specific cancer type



## 3. Choose the Hospital

The list of hospitals and relevant community services available will be listed.

## Accessing My Cancer Treatment reports

Now that you have located your cancer service, you can access the report and compare it with similar services from other hospitals.

Select the hospital from the list and it will appear on the map, with two icons.



## Read the Report

To read the detailed report select the report icon. The reports includes a range of information on the quality of the service provided.
